Church Administrative Support

In April the Annual Meeting voted unanimously to explore employing a part-time administrator to assist Ben with the running of the church.


After various discussions, we have decided:

- We will employ someone on a temporary basis, hopefully for a year, to see if this can have the impact we hope it will.
- We will pay £9 per hour, for 5-10 hours per week.
- For every £1 we raise, the PCC will set aside an extra 15p from the general fund, as an additional Common Fund donation.

If you would like to donate towards this trial period – we have about £1,800 of the £4,000 we need – please write 'ADMIN' on one of the yellow envelopes. All our fundraising events will go to this until further notice.

Church Shed and Children's Room

You may (or may not!) know we have a shed at the back of church, in a state and needing to be replaced. At the same time it is becoming clear that we need a space for working with children on Sunday mornings.



The PCC have decided to explore whether we can solve those two problems at once, by building an extension at the back of church (where the shed and the bins currently are) to include a large storage area, a children's room, and a second toilet with baby-changing facilities.


