### Reopening the Church Building

During September we will be holding services in the church building every Sunday at 10am. The latest legal changes do not affect Places of Worship, so we are still able to hold these services as planned.

Please note the following essential information:

- **Booking is required.** Please call the church office (62573) during the week to book a place for that weekend's service. **If you haven't booked, please don't come as there won't be space.** Booking helps us limit space, and keep NHS Test & Trace records.
- **Face-coverings are required.** This is a legal requirement, and we don't have any so you'll need to bring your own – if you don't bring one I'm afraid you won't be allowed to enter. (If you have a medical exemption please let us know when you book.)
- We can safely fit only eight households in the building. Therefore we are giving **priority to people who don't have access to our online services.**
- **If you do access those services, but still want to come,** please call the office. You will be put on a waiting list, which we will use to fill any remaining spaces at the end of the week.

The services will be Morning Prayer (i.e. not Holy Communion), and at present no singing is allowed. The words will be on the screens. The toilet will be open (though the services will be necessarily very short). We are not able to offer any refreshments before or after the service.

The sad reality is that most of us will not be able to come to the building for services. Therefore, we will continue to produce the weekly online service and children's church. Ben is working on other ways to meet... if you have any ideas, please let him know!

#### Meeting with the Police

Ben had his meeting with the local policing team, and it was very positive – however the latest changes in law may well affect the plans, so please continue to pray.
