A Word from Revd Claire



September is a time of new beginnings for lots of people, our thoughts and prayers are with all those starting or returning to school and nursery in the coming days.

For us as Christians, September marks the start of the Season of Creation and as I mentioned last week we will look to re-energise our work on Eco-Church. We will also consider what we do, what we want to do and how we want to go about doing it!

As a starting point for your thoughts and prayers, I want to raise awareness of the five marks of mission.

The Five Marks of Mission have been developed by the Anglican Consultative Council since 1984. Since then, they have been widely adopted as an understanding of what contemporary mission is about. The marks were adopted by the General Synod of the Church of England in 1996 and many dioceses and other denominations used them as the basis of action plans and creative mission ideas.

The marks are:

- To proclaim the Good News of the Kingdom. (Tell)
- To teach, baptise and nurture new believers. (Teach)
- To respond to human need by loving service. (Tend)
- To seek to transform unjust structure of society, to challenge violence of every kind and to pursue peace and reconciliation. (Transform)
- To strive to safeguard the integrity of creation and sustain and renew the life of the earth. (Treasure)

How we live out our Church Family prayer to be a blessing to Amington and the world is something we can consider by looking at these marks of mission.
